## Saturday Business Institute

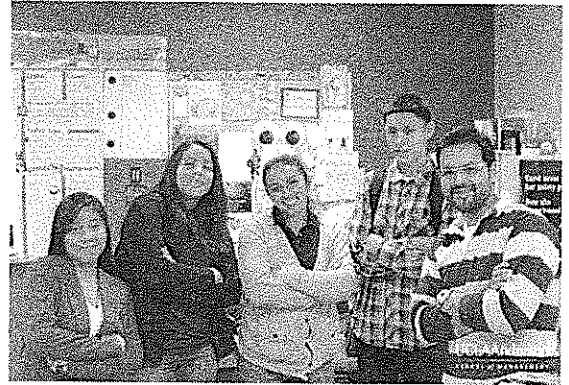
### ABOUT:

The Riordan Programs' Saturday Business Institute (SBI) is a school site-based program designed to provide high school students with college and business exposure. SBI also serves as a pipeline to our Riordan Scholars Program at UCLA Anderson School of Management. Approximately 20-25 students are selected to attend 5 Saturday sessions at each site.

The SBI Program targets incoming 9th and 10th grade students who are college-bound and interested in developing the necessary leadership skills to succeed in business and/or college. The comprehensive program includes:

- College application and financial aid workshops
- Career exploration exercises
- Professional development workshops
- Guest speakers from a variety of industries
- Mentorship
- Fieldtrips (Field Day and UCLA Visit)
