ABOUT THE PROGRAM

UCLA Bruin Weekend is a FREE 3-day intensive summer program. It provides rising 10th graders (current 9th graders) with information about being competitive applicants to UCLA and the UC system. This program focuses on the importance of higher education and presents students with a preview to the collegiate experience. The core program format consists of group workshops, presentations and campus tours. Students accepted to the program have an opportunity to live in the UCLA residence halls, giving students the full UCLA campus experience.

- Students will leave with a thorough understanding of the UC college application process
- Students will leave understanding how their attitudes and choices affect their future
- Students will learn what it takes to become a competitive applicant for a selective institution such as UCLA
- Students will have a chance to interact with current UCLA undergraduates
- Students will meet with an Admissions Officer/reader to discuss their personal academic plan

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be a current 9th grader, entering 10th grade in Fall 2019
- Have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Submit a completed application with copy of unofficial transcript attached
- Participate in all 3 days of the program: Friday, July 12th, 2019 at 8:00 am through Sunday, July 14th, 2019 at 1:00pm
- Must be affiliated with an approved UCLA college prep program or partnership organization
