SENIOR CHECKLIST

October-December

- Register for standardized tests (SAT/ACT) for October-December:
 SAT: Nov. 8, Dec. 6
 - ACT: Oct. 25, Dec. 13
- Create user name/password MASTER SHEET for all of the below accounts (as needed):
- 1. Common App account @ www.commonapp.org
- 2. CSU Mentor account @ www.csumentor.edu
- 3. UC account @ www.universityofcalifornia.edu
- 4. Community Colleges- on each school's website
- 5. Testing: collegeboard.org, actsudent.org
- Use Naviance to make sure of application deadlines & financial aid dates

SENIOR CHECKLIST

- Complete your brag sheet on Naviance (for teachers/counselors who are writing your letters of recommendations)
- Decide who the 'best teachers' are for your recommendations and ask them to write you one (4-6 weeks notice is best)
- Work on your personal statement/essay/ supplemental questions for college applications

BEFORE YOU APPLY

Reach - Target - Safety

Reach:

You want to attend. You meet all the requirements for minimum coursework. Your SAT/ACT score and unweighted GPA is at or below the average that was accepted last year

Target:

You want to attend. You meet all requirements for the recommended coursework (exceed the minimum required). Your SAT/ACT score and un-weighted GPA is at or above the average that was accepted last year.

Safety:

You want to attend. You meet all requirements for the recommended coursework (exceed the minimum required). Your SAT/ACT score and un-weighted GPA is significantly above the average that was accepted last year.

BEFORE YOU APPLY

- ✓ Thoroughly research your colleges you want to apply to and add them to your Naviance "colleges I'm thinking about" list
- ✓ Finalize your list of colleges/universities in Naviance "Colleges I'm Applying To" (must have final discussion with counselor to verify final list)
- ✓ Know your deadlines! If your college list is finalized in Naviance under "Colleges I'm applying to" it has deadlines on it for each

- (1) Counselor Evaluation/Letter of Recommendation
- (2)Teacher Evaluations/Letters of Recommendation
- Official transcripts (sent via Naviance)
- ****Send test scores from testing agency****
- Supplemental applications: Essays/Personal Statements

NAVIANCE FAMILY CONNECTION

- Electronic system for college applications and supporting documents
 - -Transcripts (initial, mid year & final)
 - -Teacher & Counselor Recommendations
 - -School profile
- Efficient (and preferred system) for colleges, students and parents
 - -Eliminates the need for paper (envelopes, stamps)\
 - -REDUCES the time needed to get documents to colleges
 - -REDUCES the chance of error and mix-up of student files
 - -Allows parents to monitor status of college applications and assist your students

HOW IT WORKS

- Students add colleges to their list on Naviance Family Connection
- Students create Common Application account and sign FERPA waiver on the Common App side (this links to Da Vinci Design and allows us to electronically send their documents directly to the college)
- Counselors submit transcripts/letters to colleges electronically by the click of a button
- Students can request recommendations from teachers
- Not ALL colleges accept electronic submissions, so some colleges will have to be sent via postal mail

October 1 – CSS Profile opens

October 11 – SAT test

October 25 – ACT test

November 8 – SAT test

November 30 – Deadline for all UC/CSU applications

December 6 – SAT test date (last chance)

December 13 – ACT test date (last chance)

January 1 – FAFSA Opens

January 2 – Deadline for most private college applications (dates vary- check Naviance!)

IMPORTANT DATES AND DOCUMENTS NEEDED

October 1: CSS Profile (for private colleges) becomes available

- Tax return from previous year (2014)
- W-2 Forms from previous year (2014)
- Records of Investments

January 1: FAFSA becomes available

- Current year tax returns (2014)
- W-2 from current year (2014)

March 2: FAFSA and Cal Grant MUST be filed

*** If applying to private schools, please check their websites for deadlines***

WHAT CAN WE DO NOW?

- Create accounts for scholarship searches and apply!
 - Fastweb.com
 - Cappex.com
 - Scholarships.com
- Research the cost of education of potential universities student might attend- Use the net price calculator on each website
- Stay organized with documents need for FAFSA and CSS Profile
- File your taxes as early as possible to complete your FAFSA and get as much financial aid eligible!

IMPORTANT:

- Send test scores directly through the testing agency no later than December 15th or as soon as scores are in.
- Meet all college application deadlines. Visit Naviance
- Request official transcripts 4-6 weeks before deadlines- on Naviance
- Check your email frequently
- Keep your grades up. All acceptances are conditional.
