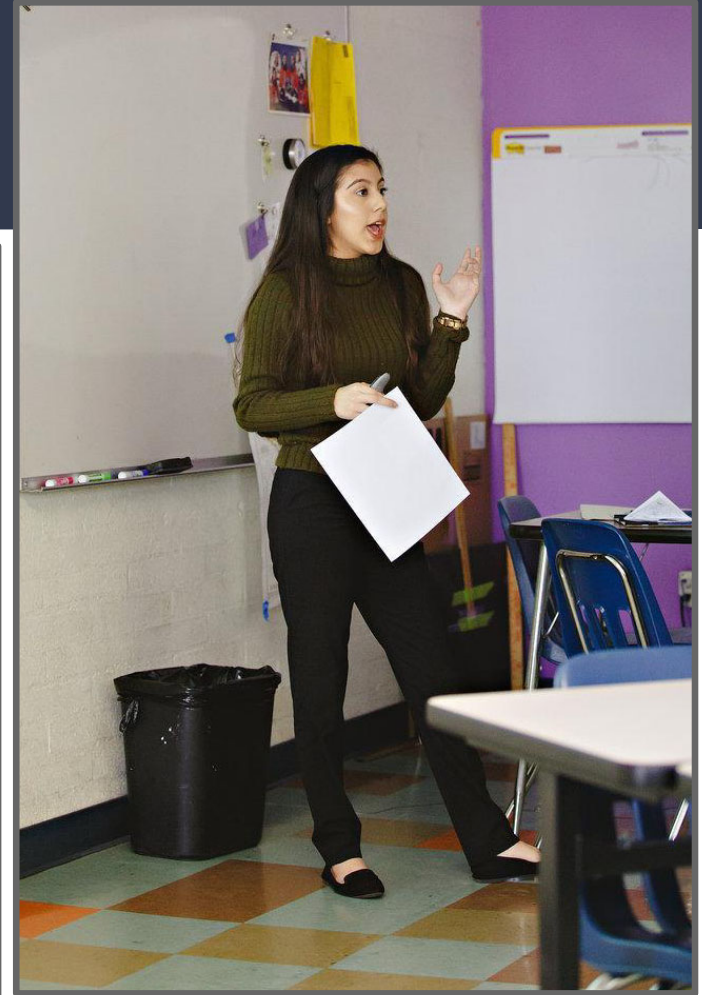
Attendance and Tardies

- Wear a belt if pants are bit loose

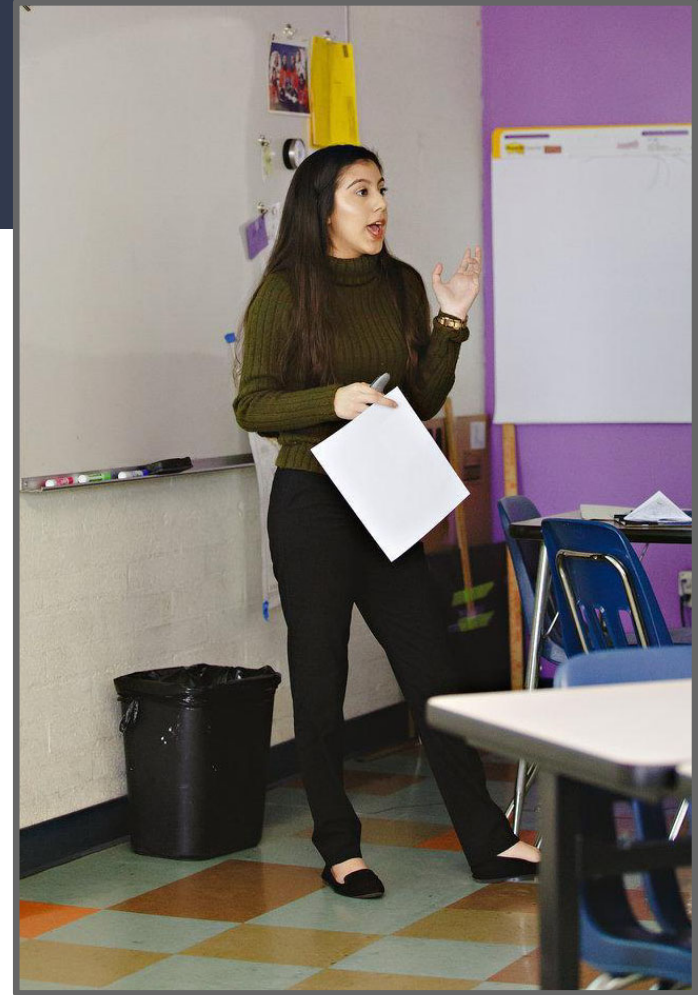
