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



Honors Courses

Honors courses at DVD...

- Are <u>NOT</u> separate classes; students can earn honors in their "regular" classes.
- Can be earned by <u>any</u> student at DVD.
- Require additional work like an honors project, extra assignments, etc.
- Must demonstrate a high level of content mastery.
- Are typically rolled out by teachers in their classes in September.

Taking honors courses and earning high grades is the best way to:

- Show colleges that you're taking the most rigorous classes offered by your school.
- Raise your GPA! When you get an honors designation on your transcript, you also get a one-point GPA boost.

NOTE: AP classes are not offered at DV High Schools
