A vital component of this study was to gain insight from charter public schools that successfully boosted college and career access for historically marginalized students. We selected schools with high college going rates and/or high CTE pathway completion rates for Latino, Black, and/or socioeconomically disadvantaged students.²

CCSA Interviewed 10 Successful Charter Public Schools:

- Five for their college-going rates: AIMS College Prep High, Aspire Ollin University Preparatory Academy, Ednovate-USC Hybrid High College Prep, Making Waves Academy, and The Preuss School UC San Diego.
- Five for their CTE-completion rates: Birmingham Community Charter High School, Lighthouse Community Charter High, The School of Arts and Enterprise, Renaissance Arts Academy, and Da Vinci Design.

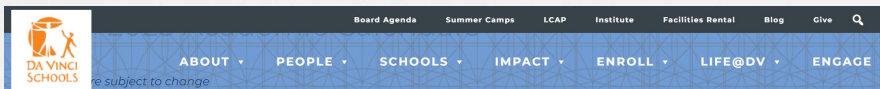

Universal Expectations: Office

Office Expectations

Be Mindful

- Enter and exit carefully.
- Keep doorways clear.
- Keep personal belongings close.
- Use school equipment appropriately.

Be Responsible

- Have a pass or appropriate reason.
- Conduct your business.
- Enter and exit office quietly.

Be Respectful

- Be kind and courteous to others.
- Follow directions the first time.
- Use school appropriate language and volume.
- Give privacy to others.
- Be mindful of visitors.

Attendance, Tardies, & Passes

- **Attendance matters: be here every day!**
 - Research shows ATTENDANCE = SUCCESS
 - Attendance also funds schools
- **Be in class on time**
 - Showing up to campus late or to class late is being tardy
 - Leaving class and staying out of class is ditching / eloping
- **Use the restroom responsibly and during passing period**
 - No restrooms for first and last 10 minutes of class, unless emergency
 - Must have restroom pass from class w/ Room #
 - Backpacks must be left outside (including passing periods)
- **Tardies will be tracked starting this week**
 - Multiple tardies including the 1st/2nd period will be counted
 - Consequence: Detention on Friday
 - Eloping will also count

Dress Code

Acceptable:	Unacceptable:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts (polos, polos, button-downs, Da Vinci apparel, must have stripes) • Pants (khaki pants, slacks, jeans) • Shorts, skirts, dresses (no shorter than mid-thigh) • Leggings, jeggings, or tights (as long as they are paired with a top, skirt, or dress that is mid-thigh in length) • Collared blazers, jackets or sweatshirts (Da Vinci, college, sweaters, jean jackets, track jackets, etc., with school appropriate top underneath) • Close-toed shoes, sandals or professional footwear 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts, dresses, and shorts that are shorter than mid-thigh, with or without leggings/tights/stockings underneath • Spaghetti or strap tops or tube tops • Muscle tank tops • See-through shirts of any kind, unless paired with an acceptable top underneath • Flip-flops or slippers • Any mask/face covering unless being used for safety/health reasons or religious beliefs • Any apparel that depicts: sexually suggestive expressions or actions, profanity, obscenity, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or any expression which depicts the integrity of individual groups • Any gang related clothing as defined by local authorities including specific colors or head coverings • Inappropriate expressions of any kind (bare midriffs, low-cut tops, large tattoos in pants, etc.)



Personal Tech on campus

- X Moving forward all classrooms will have Green/Red signs.
- X If a student is allowed to use tech in class, sign must be green
- X If a student is not allowed, sign will be red.
- X All teachers will follow protocol for all tech items:
 - Includes AirPods, Apple Watches, and Tech Accessories.*
 - Re-state Expectations at the beginning of every period
 - 1st Warning - Confiscate till end of period
 - 2nd Warning - Confiscate and turn in to front office (End of day)
 - 3rd Warning - Parent Pickup



CLASSROOM EXPECTATION PRESENTATION SLIDES

Appropriate Language/Volume

- Use **school appropriate language at all times**
 - No curse words or swearing
 - No jokes about sex/body parts
 - No jokes about race/ethnicity
 - No jokes about gender/sexual orientation
- Any student reported to use inappropriate language will be addressed
- Any report of using racial slurs or inappropriate racial language/jokes will be investigated
- If something is making you uncomfortable, tell a teacher, counselor, or admin immediately



Horseplay / Play Fighting

- **Keep hands and feet to yourselves at all times**
- "Play fighting" IS still fighting
- There is no excuse for fighting:
 - Self-defense means you are getting away; retaliation is *not* self-defense
 - Joking/threatening will be taken seriously
 - Planning to fight is unacceptable



Drug Prevention and Awareness

- X Being high on marijuana or any other drug often **interferes with normal life.**
- X **It is difficult to retain information while high**, so using marijuana, especially daily, affects your ability to learn.
- X Remember: as an underage person, **it is illegal** for you to use or possess tobacco, marijuana, alcohol or any illicit drug.
- X In addition to **serious schools consequences** if caught, you could: be arrested, lose driver's license, be denied college loan, rejected from college.
- X You risk **damaging relationships and losing trust**

AEROSOLIZING OR "VAPING"

- THC concentrate is aerosolized
- 5-10 seconds to feel the effect
- High lasts 30 minutes to several hours
- THC concentration depends on liquid often mislabeled
- Not harmless

Coming soon: Community Learning Days!

You miss a school day.

You complete the STIS Google Form.

That's it!

You experience a Community Learning Day, or a day you are not in school but are still able to learn or complete your school work.

You take 3-5 minutes to complete a Google Form explaining what you learned on the date of your absence.

The school reviews what you learned while absent and marks your absence as an independent study day if it qualifies. You may be asked to revise so provide details!





Reminders For Parents:

- ✘ How might I help my student best prepare for the upcoming school year?
 - Help them re-establish a strong sleep schedule; come up with a “**morning routine**” that works for them and gets them to school on time
 - Make sure they are here every day (**attendance matters!**)
 - Help establish healthy boundaries with technology; **limit screen time** and phone time to prepare students for classes
 - ***Remind students that students must have cell phones away during instruction.***
 - Lunch: free at school or from home (**not from DoorDash, UberEats, etc.**)
 - Remind them to **be in dress code**

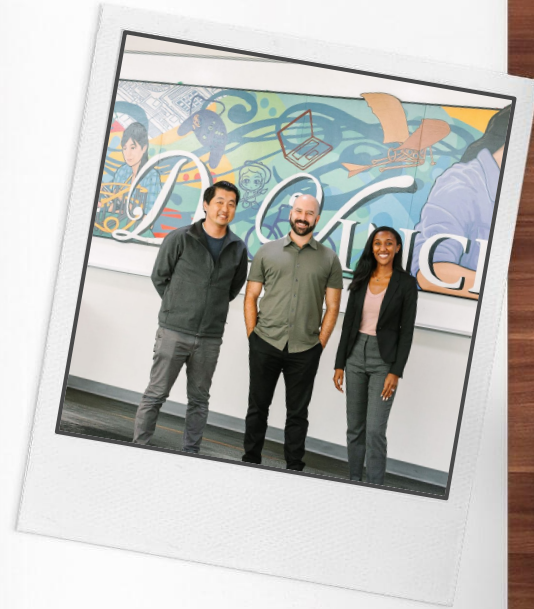
