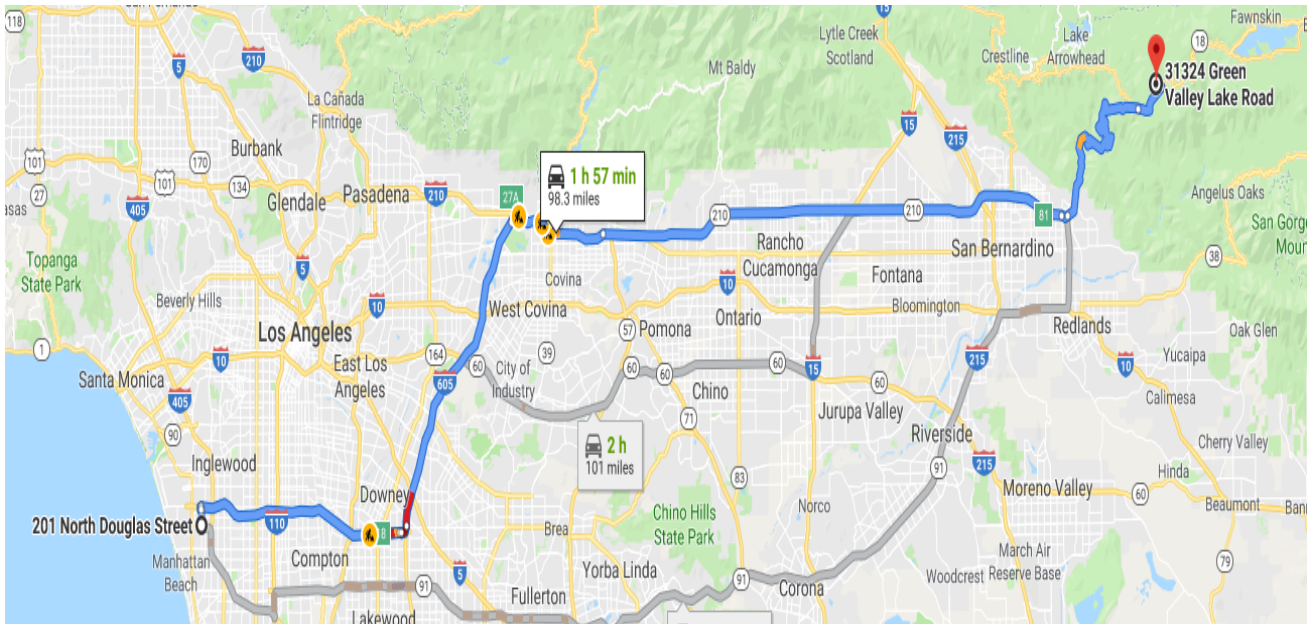


CAMP PONDO RETREAT INFORMATION
